LANE FILTERING IS LEGAL BEGINNING ON SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 24TH, 2022

What is Lane Filtering?

Lane Filtering is when motorcyclists move between two lanes to the front of traffic that is stopped at an intersection.

Motorcycle Lane Filtering was made legal under certain circumstances in Arizona and goes in to effect on Saturday, September 24, 2022.

Lane Filtering was designed to prevent or reduce rear-end collisions between approaching vehicles and motorcycles stopped in traffic.

Lane Filtering is intended to provide a "safety pocket" for motorcycles when encountering stopped traffic.

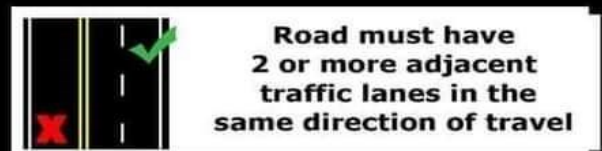
How does Lane Filtering work?

The speed limit can't be greater than 45 mph.

The motorcyclist speed can't exceed 15 mph.

Traffic must be stopped.

Road must have 2 or more adjacent traffic lanes in the same direction of travel.

To use Teamup, you go to **teamup.com** on your computer or get the Teamup Calendar app. When you have done this, you will create an account. On the computer it will ask you to confirm your email address and when it does it will ask you to login. Now it will say create a new calendar or existing one. On a cell phone you add the App. If you have not already created an account, you will do it now. If you did or finished creating your account login, it will say “create a calendar” in larger print, but below it in smaller print it will say “**open existing account**”. It's getting colder, so before you ride check your bike out, as I know it has been several months for some. Reminder, even if you were out on your bike yesterday check it out before riding.

Women's Freedom Ride

1: Tires, check your tires to make sure they are properly inflated. Every rider should know the proper PSI rating for their tires. Checking them when they are cold is best. Check them for any wear, anything embedded, broken or damaged spokes and rims, and make sure the tread is adequate.

Women's Freedom Ride

2: Lights, Make sure all lights are in good working order. Head lights (High and Low Beam), Brake lights and Turn Signals. Check that the covers are not loose or cracked, are free of dirt and bugs, and that the bulbs are bright enough to be seen. (Always carry extra fuses.)

Women's Freedom Ride

3: Controls. Make sure your cables are in good condition, not worn or frayed, no kinks or bends, and are securely connected. Check your clutch and brake levers, make sure they are not loose, that they pull easily and return to their proper position. Look at your brake and shifter, make sure they are attached securely, not bent, and in proper working order. Double Check Your Brakes.

Women's Freedom Ride

4: Fluids. Check your fluids, make sure your oil level is sufficient. Improper oil level could damage your bike. Everyone should know their bikes correct oil weight, and how to check and fill it properly. Check your gas, you may have used more or forgotten to fill up after your last ride. Your boots are not made for walking.

Women's Freedom Ride

5: Kickstand. Check that it is properly attached, not loose, wobbly or bent. You don't want to be riding down the road, look in your mirror, and see your kickstand bouncing down the road behind you.

The goal is to enjoy the ride and arrive safely.
